

1987 LAHS 20th Year Reunion Golf Tournament Rules

FORMAT: 18 Hole Tournament - four person blind bogey scramble tournament.

RULES: All rules interpretations will be handled and resolved by the Golf Nazis “Susan Brockway or Hop”.

1. A scramble means that all four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
3. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.
4. Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.
5. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
6. Each team must use at least one of each team members tee shots on each nine (minimum two tee shots per player).
7. Men tee off from the **blue** tees and women from the **red** tees.
8. There will be a number draw after the tournament to determine the Six blind bogey holes.
9. Enjoy your day and most importantly the beer!

AWARDS: The following categories will receive awards:

<u>Team Awards</u> 18 holes:	Team with lowest net after Blind Bogeys have been determined wins the Grand Prize! Please provide final scorecards to Hop for entry.
<u>Individual Awards</u> 18 holes:	Closest to the Pin, Longest Drive, and Worst Frickin’ Shot

CONTESTS:

Hole #17 - Closest to the Pin: If your tee shot is closest to the Pin/Hole, write your name and distance on the card and place the marker in the ground on the spot where your ball came to rest. Once the marker has been placed in the ground, it should stay there until someone else hits a closer shot. Use the flagstick as a measuring rod if it is a close call. Then, that person should repeat the procedure of writing their name on the card below the other name(s) and place the marker at the spot.

Hole #8 - Longest Drive: If your drive is the longest and within the fairway, write your name on the marker card and place the marker in the ground on the spot where your ball lays. Once the marker has been placed in the ground, it should stay there until someone else makes a drive longer than yours. Then, that person should repeat the procedure of writing their name on the card below the other name(s) and place the marker at the spot.

Any Hole - Worst Frickin’ Shot: This award only applies to all unintentional and or accidental crappy shots. All teams will be required to describe in writing what happened to qualify the worst shot, for example: **“Hop hits his t-shot and it dribbles 10 yards before hitting a tree and bouncing back behind the foursome as his competitive wife voices her displeasure in his golfing abilities)”**. Please note that the worst shot doesn’t have to be played in regulation to qualify. Provide the written description to Hop for entry.
